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## REPORTING **SAFE** VERSES **UNSAFE** VISITS:

When being prompted to record a safe or unsafe visit when clocking out of our shifts.

**PLEASE remember that our refusal codes cards. #4 indicates Change in Condition: Problem = "Unsafe Visit"**

This should include making a call to your Staffing Supervisor or On-Call to be sure all is being addressed.



At this time, there are no plans to make the COVID-19 vaccine mandatory for any of our employees. However, we encourage everyone to consider whether getting the vaccine to protect yourself and others makes sense for you. Based on our information, front-line Phase 1A Healthcare Personnel not affiliated with a hospital or health system may be eligible to receive the vaccine at this time.

If you are interested in receiving this vaccine, please contact your direct supervisor, and she will send you a personalized letter that indicates the type of work you perform for our organization to present at time of vaccination. You will also want to bring your employee badge as well for further verification.

We understand there should be no cost to you however, confirm this when scheduling your appointment.

As a reminder, having the COVID vaccine is not a condition of employment or a requirement for the work you perform for our organization.
